Scholarships for talented students who are particularly characterised by social commitment



The Stiftung zur Förderung begabter Studierender und des wissenschaftlichen Nachwuchses des Landes Rheinland-Pfalz, hereinafter referred to as the Scholarship Foundation for short, has established a funding programme aimed at talented students who distinguish themselves in a special way through their social commitment.

Facts about the scholarship for particularly socially committed students

- 300 €/Month
- Approval for one year
- Extension is generally possible until the standard period of study is reached
- There is no legal entitlement to funding or an extension of funding.

Requirements

- Positive vote by the university's own awards committee.
- Funding for students who are enrolled at a university in Rhineland-Palatinate and are not enrolled in a non-fee-financed study programme
- The applicant student may not receive any other talent- and performance-related material support from one of the measures or institutions listed in Section 1 (3) of the Scholarship Programme Act or from any other domestic or foreign institution. BAföG benefits are not included in the material support mentioned here and do not preclude this scholarship.

Selection criteria

- a) for first-year students
 - average grades of the higher education entrance qualification or
 - the special qualification that entitles the holder to study in the respective degree programme or
 - the academic achievements of any previous university degree programme
- b) for students who are already enrolled
 - the academic achievements to date
 - for students of a Master's degree programme also the final grade of the previous degree programme
- c) Additional selection criterion for both groups according to a) and b): special social commitment
 - Commitment at the university, e.g. student councils, StuPa, AStA, student initiatives and projects, provided these activities are not remunerated
 - Commitment outside the university, e.g. long-term voluntary work and taking on responsibility in associations and initiatives (an expense allowance of up to 50 euros is not harmful)

Announcement and tendering

Scholarships are announced at the beginning of each semester. The number of scholarships awarded depends on the foundation funds provided and the existing scholarship contracts.

The university management will invite applications for scholarships via the university website and by mailing. The number of scholarships to be awarded, the application deadline and the application modalities will be announced.

Application

Applications can only be submitted using the form provided. Only applications that have been completed in full by the application deadline with all the required supporting documents will be considered by the university's internal admissions committee. Applications received after the application deadline or subsequently submitted documents will not be considered.
