## HiWi, Bachelor- or Master Theses in the project "Open Digitization Alliance Palatinate" in the innovation area "Health"



The aim of the collaborative project "Open Digitization Alliance Palatinate" of the University of Kaiserslautern, the University of Kaiserslautern and the Fraunhofer Institute for Industrial Mathematics ITWM is to help shape the digital transformation and to create a distinctive culture of innovation, with subjects of high economic and social relevance.
