

## Questionnaire

In the interview round with the applicants, the selection committee will ask 3-4 questions of the applicants. The questionnaire serves as a preparation and suggestion in this regard; it reflects the questions submitted in the course of the past years in excerpts. The questionnaire can be extended as desired and should be made available to students in advance as a preparation. Of course, spontaneous questions can also be posed to the applicants.

## Questions to get to know each other

- Where do you see decisive milestones for your personal development?
- Who has been the most influential person in your life?
- If you could change three things in the world, what would they be?
- If you could meet one historical person for dinner, who would that be and what would you like to ask them?
- What bad habit would you like to get rid of?
- What is the best book you have read so far and what impressed you about it?
- What does happiness mean to you?

## Questions about the study

- Explain in one sentence why you chose your degree programme?
- What is your dream job and why?
- What is the best thing about your degree programme?
- What has been your greatest success in your studies so far?
- If you were President of Kaiserslautern University of Applied Sciences for one day, what would you introduce?
- In which part-time job have you learned the most so far?

## Questions to think about

- Do you think that fear of punishment stops someone from committing a crime?
- Do you prefer to look out of the window or into your laptop when you're travelling by train?
- If you could make one rule that everyone had to follow, what rule would it be?
- If you no longer had to sleep, what would you do with the extra time?
- What is the probability that humanity will encounter extraterrestrial life?

- With the door closed, how can you test whether an automatic light in the bathroom actually goes out?
- Estimate: How many sheets of paper are copied in Germany every day?
